### What time is the event?

Those who register to either buy or sell are allowed entry at 9:00 am. Unregistered individuals will be admitted at 9:30 am. The event closes at 11:00 am.

### Is there a cost to attend?

### Where is it held?

Weyauwega-Fremont High School Commons. Enter through the main doors.

### How much room do I have to sell?

Each seller will have one table in the high school commons for their use. We encourage you to bring 10 or less items to fit on the table. Tables assigned on first register, first available.

### How are items labeled?

Each seller is responsible for clearly labeling all items with a price, as well as having their contact information posted at each table.

### How do we pay for items purchased?

Each seller decides if they want to accept cash, check, or another form of online payment such as Venmo or PayPal. We suggest buyers be prepared for any of the above.

### What happens to the unsold items I bring?

Sellers can take their unsold items home or give to the Club for use/donation.

### If I cannot attend and have items to sell, can I drop them off or donate to the Club?
